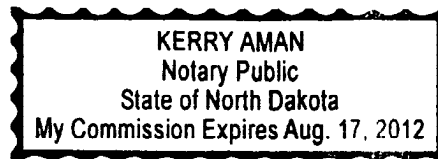

## **WHY?**

This meeting is designed to allow for public input which is required for compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1970 and National Historic Preservation Act of 1966.

The North Dakota Department of Transportation and the city of West Fargo are preparing an Environmental Assessment for improvement alternatives for Main Avenue from I-94 west to 45<sup>th</sup> Street West. This meeting is to inform the public on the progress of the project, to receive input as to the different improvement alternatives, and to document concerns on the development of these alternatives. The overall project consists of reconstructing the roadway, which may include widening and/or realignment outside the existing right of way.

Representatives from NDDOT and the city of West Fargo will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.

All meeting notices, including executive sessions, must contain the following information: date, time, and location; topics to be considered where such listing is practicable (for example, not with the annual filing of regularly scheduled meetings) (note: topics discussed at an emergency or special meeting are limited to those included in the notice); general subject matter of any executive session expected to be held during the meeting; telephone or video conferences must include the location of the speaker phone or monitor; a telephone number for arranging special accommodations.
